[Access to Ugata Sta.]

- From Kintetsu-Nagoya Sta.: approx. 2h 10min by Limited Express
- From Osaka-Namba Sta.: approx. 2h 30min by Limited Express
- From Kyoto Sta.: approx. 3h by Limited Express (transferring at Yamato-Yagi Sta.)

- Each figure on the map indicates the actual measured distance (in meters) from the starting point.
- Since Teku Teku Map is illustrated, when actually walking the course, please prepare a detailed map yourself.
